Jacqueline Larson, MD, is a pediatric gastroenterologist at Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital. She treats pediatric patients with numerous gastrointestinal diseases including inflammatory bowel disease (Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis), celiac disease, eosinophilic gastrointestinal disorders (eosinophilic esophagitis, eosinophilic gastritis, eosinophilic gastroenteritis, eosinophilic colitis, etc.), non-alcoholic fatty liver disease, obesity and other conditions.

As someone living with Crohn's disease for more than 35 years and celiac disease for 15 years, Dr. Larson brings unique perspectives, empathy and understanding to the gastroenterology field.

Before becoming a physician, Dr. Larson worked as a cellular biologist for the University of Colorado. She went on to attend medical school at St. George's University in St. George's, Grenada. As a pediatric resident, she became interested in lifestyle medicine and was actively involved in several school-based wellness programs. She moved to South Florida for her pediatric gastroenterology, hepatology and nutrition fellowship at University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Medical Center.

In addition to providing patient care, Dr. Larson is actively involved as a member, volunteer, speaker and committee member for the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation (CCF). She serves as a member of the Chapter Medical Advisory Committee and is involved in the patient education subcommittee. She is also a member of the North American Society for Pediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition (NASPGHAN) and the American Gastroenterological Association (AGA).
